cast seated in vajraparyankasana with the hands held in dhyanamudra in place to support a vessel containing the elixir of longevity, the face with a serene expression below a high chignon, a celestial scarf encircling the shoulders and arms, dressed in a dhoti with finely chased borders, supported on a cloisonné enamel double-lotus base and backed by a cloisonné enamel mandorla, sealed with a base plate chased with a double-vajra
