MEISSEN 'INDIAN PINK' PORCELAIN PART DINNER, TEA AND COFFEE SERVICE LATE 19TH/ EARLY 20TH CENTURY

decorated with a small central flower head within scrolling flowers and gilt triangular rim-borders, variously marked with blue crossed swords marks, painted and impressed markings, comprising a covered soup tureen and stand, tureen 26.5cm high; two squared salad bowls, 23cm wide; a covered vegetable bowl, 18cm high; a further covered vegetable bowl with integral stand, 16cm high; two covered condiment pots and under plates, 11cm long; pair of figural salt stands, incised 2874 and 2875, 11cm long; a fish platter, 55cm long; an oval serving dish, 23cm long; 14 dinner plates, 25.5cm diam.; seven soup plates, 23cm diam.; six dessert plates, 20cm diam.; six side/bread plates, 15cm diam.; eight lattice-rimmed plates, 23cm diam.; 11 lattice-rimmed plates, 20.5cm diam.; two spoons, 22cm long; a covered coffee pot, 26cm high; a covered tea pot, 12cm high; a milk jug, 12cm high; a covered sugar bowl, 10cm high; 12 tea cups, 5cm high; 12 saucers, 15cm diam.; 12 plates, 18cm diam.; and a cake plate, 28cm diam.
