CYPRIOI TREFOIL JUG CYPRUS, CYPRO-ARCHAIC I, C. 750 - 600 B.C.

terracotta and painted pigment, sitting on a ring base, the globular body leading to a short neck and trefoil mouth with a bifurcated handle, the central register with a depiction of a deity reaching towards a sacred tree with a bird below, the sides and neck with the conventional ornament of concentric circles and connecting bands in black and umber, the reverse with a depiction of a large lotus flower
