WHITE AND RUSSET JADE 'TAOTIE' CUP WITH DRAGON AND CHILONG HANDLES MING DYNASTY, 16TH-17TH CENTURY

raised on a stepped ring foot, the quatrefoil form cup carved in low relief on either side with an archaic *taotie* mask flanked by a stylised phoenix head, the vessel flanked with a *chilong* clambering up from the bottom to the slightly everted rim on one side, the other side carved with a protruding horned dragon head forming handles, the creamy-white stone has some dark brown russet section, with a fitted wooden stand
